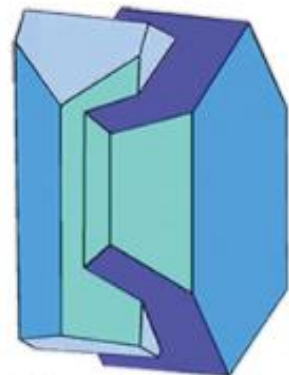

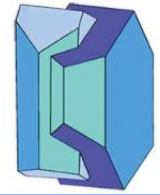

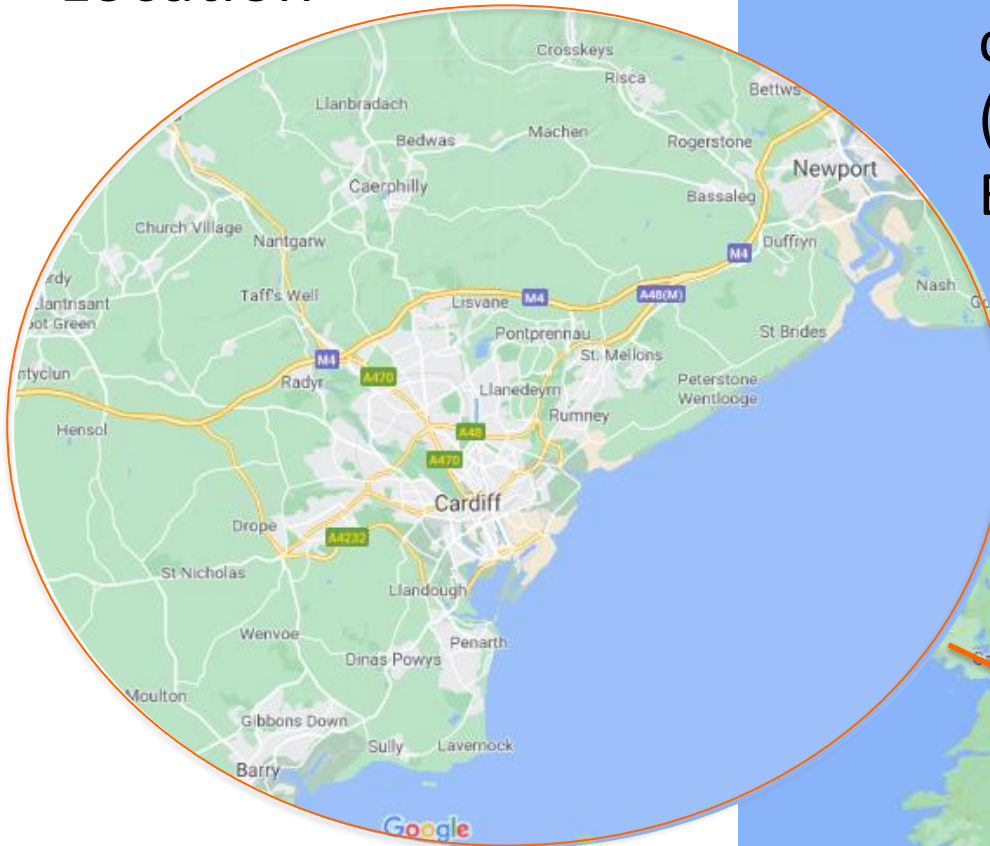

## Location

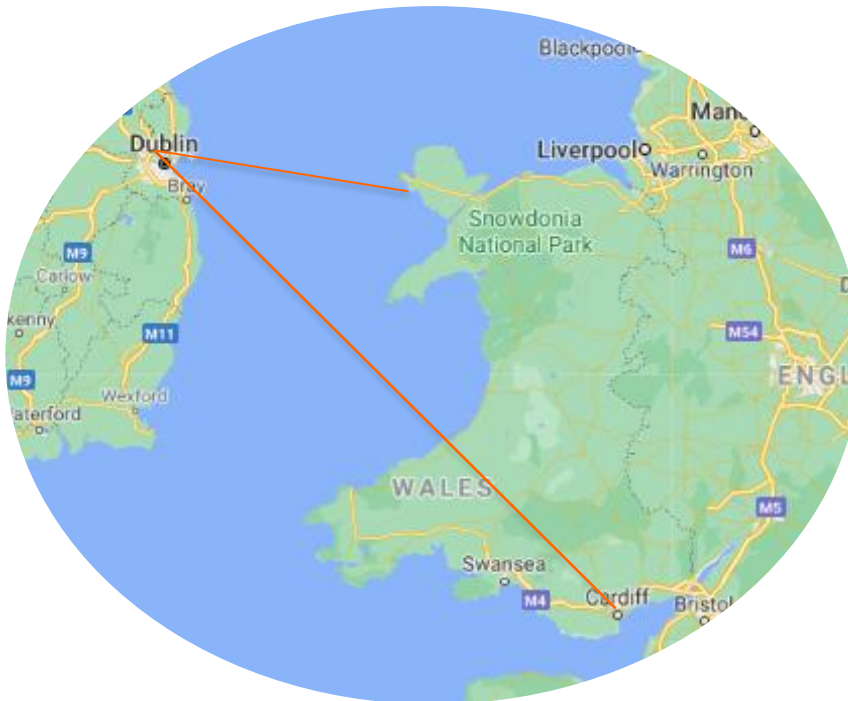
Cardiff is conveniently located for field trips, some options, both 1-day & longer, include

- Dolyhir Quarry - site with 75 mineral species, with rare & complex paragenesis.
- Parys Mountain, N Wales- massive sulphide deposit, largest Cu mine in the world in C18
- The Lizard Complex, SW England, classic British geology, obducted and deformed Palaeozoic oceanic crust.
